Overview of the Program

The Falls Church City Green Home Certification Program highlights residential construction projects built and certified to be friendly to the environment both during and after construction.

Eligible projects will receive a yard sign showing the project is part of this program. This sign can be displayed at the site during construction. Once the house is completed, the HERS rater must certify successful completion of an approved green building program.

To participate in this program, file this application, along with a copy of the application to the certifying agency and a copy of the contract with a HERS rater.
