Larceny from Vehicle, W Broad St, March 14, unknown suspect(s) removed an item of value from a vehicle on a sales lot.

Larceny from Building, Wilson Blvd, March 15, 3:18 PM, two male suspects took three large screen TV's from a business, but were unable to load one on to their black Ford F150 pickup truck, as it was too large. Suspects described as: (S1) wearing dark clothing with a beard, and (S2) wearing light colored clothing with glasses.

Burglary, W Broad St, March 17, 3:10 AM, unknown suspect shattered the front door of a business and took items of value. Suspect described as an adult male, 6'00, slim build, 20-30 years of age, wearing gloves, a white hooded jacket, white pants, and white sneakers.

Hit and Run/Destruction of Property, W Broad St, March 17, 12:26 PM, unknown suspect, driving a stolen Jeep, drove on to the sidewalk, hit a pedestrian, a telephone utility box and two parked cars. Suspect described as a black male, approximately 25 years old, with a beard and receding hairline, wearing a blue hoody with bleach print, and tan pants. Pedestrian declined medical care. Stolen Auto, W Broad St, March 17, 12:45 PM, an 88-year-old male was loading groceries into his Ford Taurus which was then stolen. The victim received an injury to the back of his head and was transported by Medics. The suspect was identified as the same person involved in the hit and run/destruction of property. Drunk in Public, W Broad St, March 17, 6:15 PM, a white male, 45, of Falls Church, VA, was arrested for Drunk in Public.

Carjacking/Malicious Wounding, W Broad St, March 19, 3:47 PM, a suspect assaulted and attempted to carjack a vehicle. A black male, who refused to identify himself, was arrested for Felony Carjacking, Felony Malicious Wounding and Destruction of Property. The victim was transported with non-life threatening injuries. The arrestee was identified as the same suspect involved in the previous stolen auto and hit and run/destruction of property.
