Enclosed is the application for the City of Falls Church FY2023 Real Estate and Personal Property/Auto Decal Relief Programs. Applications are due no later than April 15, 2022. You are encouraged to apply as early as possible.

Please read the attached program information carefully to ensure your application is complete. The amount of your grant will depend on your income and your assets. For this reason, it is important to document income and assets carefully. Assets will be documented from your December 2021 bank statements, brokerage statements, and other savings or investment documents. Your 2021 tax returns (federal and state) must be submitted with your application. Please include copies of all asset and income documentation with your application to make certain that you receive the relief to which you are entitled.

If you have a Reverse Mortgage or if your property is held in a trust, please provide a copy of the trust documents or the Reverse Mortgage Agreement with your application. Please include a copy of your Power of Attorney (POA), if applicable along with the contact information of your POA contact.

Please contact the Treasurer's Office directly if you are a 100% service-connected, permanently and totally disabled veteran. You will be required to submit your Summary of Benefits letter from the US Department of Veteran's Affairs to qualify for the City's veteran's tax exemption.
